

**ORDINANCE 09-03**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TOLAR, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND NAMING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the City Council under the Laws of the State of Texas to approve a fiscal year budget for the operation of City Government in providing services and community development; and

**WHEREAS**, public hearings for citizen participation have been scheduled and completed for consideration of the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2009-2010;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOLAR, TEXAS;**

**SECTION 1.           ADOPTION OF FISCAL BUDGET**

That the proposed annual budget for the fiscal year of the City of Tolar, Texas, commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2009, and ending on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, heretofore prepared and submitted to the City Council by the Mayor be approved and adopted. Copies of said budget shall be kept on file in the office of the City Secretary.

**SECTION 2.           SEVERABILITY CLAUSE**

That if any section, provision, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance, and the City Council of the City of Tolar, Texas hereby declares it would have enacted such remaining portions, despite such invalidity.

**SECTION 3.           REPEALING CLAUSE**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent on conflict only.

**SECTION 4.           REPEALING CLAUSE**

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication ads required by law.
